

Facts and Stats on the Children's Village:

- Founded in 1999 with 9 orphaned children rescued from the streets of Kenya
- Has Two Campuses:
 - St. Francis School/Home for Boys, which is home to 570 boys
 - St. Clare Girls' Center, which is home to 140 girls. A new facility to house 500 girls is being built.
- Three schools, K-12, staffed by 30 teachers
- 95% of the children are orphaned by the HIV pandemic
- Village is maintained by 15 staff workers (cooks, bakers, seamstress, farm workers, construction, and maintenance workers)
- Children come from 17 different Kenyan tribes and diverse religious backgrounds
- The cost of educating, feeding and clothing one child for one year is \$480 USD
- Food produced on the Village farm
- Built and sustained totally by donations
